



## **Graduating Class Profile Academic Year 2010-2011**

### **Executive Summary**

Each summer, the Office of Institutional Research and Assessment prepares the Graduating Class Profile Report. This year's report contains information on the 2010-2011 academic year graduates. Basic demographics are included as well as information on how long the graduates have attended Southeastern and from which institutions students transferred.

During the 2010-2011 academic year, Southeastern conferred a total of 2,549 degrees, an increase of 180 (8%) degrees from the 2009-2010 academic year. Seventy-seven percent (77%) of baccalaureate degree recipients are White, Non-Hispanic, while sixty-four percent (64%) are female.

Some highlights from the tables include:

- Twenty-three percent (23%) of the graduates who started as beginning freshmen graduated within four years, which is the same as the 2009-2010 graduating class. Twenty-two percent (22%) of the transfers attended for four years, while twenty-seven percent (27%) attended for three years.
- The most frequently occurring number of years at Southeastern is five for beginning freshmen and three for transfer students.
- Southeastern's leading feeder school is Louisiana State University – Baton Rouge, followed by Baton Rouge Community College, Delgado, University of Louisiana-Lafayette, University of New Orleans, River Parishes Community College, and Nicholls State University. The only change from last year is that Nicholls State University replaced Northwestern State University.
- The undergraduate program with the highest number of graduates in 2010-2011 is the B.G.S. in General Studies. This program is followed by the B.A. in Management, B.S. in Nursing, B.B.A. in Business Administration, and B.S. Accounting. This grouping is identical to last year.
- The baccalaureate programs (at least 5 graduates) with the highest percentage of students who began as transfers are B.A. Art Education, followed by B.S. Sport Management, B.S. Health & Physical Education, and B.S. Nursing. In contrast, the programs with the lowest percentage of transfers are B.S. Middle School Education, B.S. Mathematics, B.A. English, B.S. Communication Sciences and Disorders, and B.A. Social Studies Education.
- Sixty-five percent (65%) of the baccalaureate degree recipients started at Southeastern as beginning freshmen. This is up two percentage points over last year.
