



Graduating Class Profile 2019-2020

Executive Summary

Each summer, the Office of Institutional Research prepares the Graduating Class Profile Report. This year's report contains information on the 2019-2020 graduates. Basic demographics are included as well as information on how long the graduates have attended Southeastern and from which institutions students last transferred.

During the 2019-2020 academic year Southeastern conferred a total of 2,136 degrees, an increase of 57 (2.7%) degrees from 2018-2019. Sixty-eight percent (68%) of baccalaureate degree recipients are White, Non-Hispanic, while sixty-five percent (65%) are female.

Some highlights include:

- Twenty-seven percent (27%) of the graduates classified as Beginning Freshmen graduated within four years. This is three percentage points lower from the 2018-2019 graduating class.
- For transfer students, Southeastern's leading feeder school is Baton Rouge Community College followed by Louisiana State University, Delgado Community College, Northshore Technical Community College, River Parishes Community College, University of Louisiana-Lafayette, University of New Orleans, Louisiana State University-Eunice, Nicholls State University, and Northwestern State University.
- The undergraduate baccalaureate program with the highest number of graduates in 2019-2020 is the B.G.S. General Studies. The B.S.N. Nursing, B.A. Management, B.S. Biological Sciences, B.S. Kinesiology, and B.A. Psychology follow with the highest number of graduates.
- The baccalaureate programs (at least 5 graduates) with the highest percentage of students who began as transfers are: B.S. Elementary Education & Special Education followed by B.S. Supply Chain Management, B.S. Engineering Technology, B.G.S. General Studies, B.A. Social Work, B.S.N. Nursing, and B.S. Elementary Education. In contrast, the programs with the lowest percentage of transfers are B.A. Sociology, followed by B.S. Middle School Education, B.M. Music, B.A. History, B.S. Athletic Training, B.S. Health Systems Management, B.A. Political Science, and B.S. Sport Management.
- Sixty-nine percent (69%) of the baccalaureate degree recipients started at Southeastern as Beginning Freshmen. This is roughly the same percentage from last year.
