**I. CALL TO ORDER**

Dr. Shirley Jacob called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

**II APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

The minutes from the February 7, 2000 meeting were approved as written.

**III. DEPARTMENT OF SPECIAL EDUCATION, COMMUNICATION SCIENCES & DISORDERS**

1. In Dr. Suzanne Martin's absence, Dr. Jacob presented a change which had been omitted at the February 7, 2000 meeting:

SPED 458/558: Change the prerequisite listed as EDUC 201 to EDUC 202 as EDUC 201 will no longer be offered.

The motion was made to approve this change. Moved, seconded, and approved. VOTE PASSED.

**IV THE DEPARTMENT OF KINESIOLOGY AND HEALTH STUDIES**

1. Dr. Linda Synovitz presented the following changes in existing course/catalogue entries:

- On page 208, under "Concentration in Sports Management", ACCT 211 will be replaced with ACCT 212 because ACCT 211 is being phased out.

- HS 320: change course description to better describe course and hopefully keep out students looking for an easy elective.

- HS 332: change prerequisites to read "HS 132 and second semester sophomore status.
- Concentration in Dance: change course title from "Dance" to "Dance Studies".
- Under Graduate concentration in Health Studies: Add three courses – HS 637, HS 638, and HS 610.

The motion was made to approve these changes. Moved, seconded, and approved. VOTE PASSED.

2. Dr. Synovitz then presented three Requests for New Courses:

- HS 133 (3 hrs. credit) - Healthy Lifestyles for the 21st Century
- KIN 395 ( 3 hrs. credit) - Undergraduate - Kinesiology Seminar–junior or senior standing
- HS 610 (3 hrs. credit) - Graduate - Health Education Curriculum and Instruction

The motion was made to approve these Requests for New Courses. Moved, seconded, and approved. VOTE PASSED.

#### V. DEPARTMENT OF COUNSELING, FAMILY STUDIES, AND EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP

1. Dr. Alessi presented a request for a change in a course description:

- Special Topics in Family and Consumer Sciences - change to a three hour credit. Previously, the course offered variable credit (1,2, or 3 hrs. credit).

The motion was made to approve this change. Moved, seconded, and approved. VOTE PASSED.
