I. CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Shirley Jacob called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

II APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Dr. Jacob requested approval of the minutes from the previous meeting on September 2, 1998. It was pointed out that Dr. Parris Watts' name had been left off of the list of members present. The minutes were then approved with the addition of Dr. Watts' name.

III DEPARTMENT OF KINESIOLOGY AND HEALTH STUDIES

- Due to the reduction of hours within the Kinesiology major, and due to the fact that the courses are no longer needed, Dr. Watts requested the deletion of the following courses:

KIN 246 Athletic Training Practicum

KIN 342 Athletic Training Practicum

KIN 354 Recognition and Evaluation of Human Performance Injuries: Upper Body

KIN 356 Recognition and Evaluation of Human Performance Injuries:

Lower Body

KIN 412 Athletic Training Practicum

KIN 413 Athletic Training Practicum

KIN 461 Therapeutic Modalities and Rehabilitation Techniques in Human Performance Injuries

The motion was made to delete these courses from the Kinesiology curriculum. The motion was seconded and approved. **VOTE PASSED.**

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- Dr. Watts presented a request for change in the course title of KIN 434 as faculty within the Department of Special Education had justifiable concerns about the wording. The present title, "*Fitness Programs for Special Populations*", would be changed to "*Special Considerations for Exercise Testing and Prescription*".

The motion to approve the change in course title was made. The motion was seconded and approved. **VOTE PASSED.**

- Dr. Watts requested a change in course number, course title, and course description of KIN 534 as other changes in the curriculum related to this course necessitated the changes.

KIN 534, "*Fitness Testing and Exercise Prescription*", would become KIN 644, "*Advanced Exercise Testing and Prescription*".

The motion to approve the changes in KIN 534's course number, title, and description was made. The motion was seconded and approved. **VOTE PASSED.**

IV. DEPARTMENT OF SPECIAL EDUCATION, COMMUNICATION SCIENCES AND DISORDERS

Dr. Martin presented a request for a change in the curriculum sheet in Special Education Mild/Moderate Impairments and Elementary Education to reflect the reduction of hours from 148 to 139-140. She also pointed out that EDUC 322 has been replaced by SPED 465.

While going over the proposed curriculum sheet, committee members noticed that two changes needed to be made.

A motion to amend the original request was made and seconded. The following two changes were cited:

1. Under the second year, Health Studies 131 should be changed to Health Studies 132. (HS 132 is a prerequisite for HS 332 which should be taken the following semester)
2. Under the fourth year, Education 410 should be changed to Education 415. (EDUC 410 is a 10 hr. course and EDUC 415 is a 9 hr. course)

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A motion was made to approve the amended request. The motion was seconded and approved.
VOTE PASSED.
