- ALL TO ORDER

Dr. Sue Austin called the meeting to order at 3:03 p.m.

## II DEPARTMENT OF COUNSELING, FAMILY STUDIES, AND EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP

- Dr. Susan Cooper, representing the Family and Consumer Science faculty with the Dept. of CFSEL, presented a proposal to modify FCS 442/542 to allow the course to be "repeated for credit as topics vary". Dr. Emerson moved and Dr. Head seconded to accept the proposal. After discussion, the motion was approved without opposition.
- Dr. Cooper presented a proposal mandated by the Board of Regents, to merge the former fashion merchandising degree into the present degree in family and consumer science with three concentrations. Dr. Morgan moved and Dr. Day seconded to accept the proposal.

During discussion, several corrections were suggested. In addition, it was noted that the professional education courses listed in the vocational family and consumer sciences concentration were based upon the recommendations of a Dept. of Teacher Education Task Force which will not be considered by the Dept. of Teacher Education until Tuesday, December 2, 1997. Dr. Schisler amended the original motion to accept all corrections as noted and also accept the professional education sequence contingent upon approval by the Dept. of Teacher Education. Dr. Morgan seconded the motion. The amendment passed without opposition. The original motion as amended then was approved with one abstention.
