II. DEPARTMENT OF COUNSELING AND HUMAN DEVELOPMENT

Dr. Peggy Rolling presented the following items:

A. Family and Consumer Sciences

1. Request for Change: Change of wording to replace “Chemistry” Elective with “Physical Science” Elective in the FCS curriculum for 3 concentrations, (FCS, Fashion Merchandising, Nutrition.) Catalog Pages 215,216, 217.

2. Request for Change – FCS 342 – Deletion of the course prerequisite will increase the number of 300-400 level FCS courses available to meet student demand due to changes in course offerings in Chemistry.

Both items approved by all members present which represented a quorum of the committee.

B. Other

Dr. Mary Ballard advised the committee of upcoming changes as follows:

The Board of Regents and the State Department of Education will now allow universities to award Post Baccalaureate Certificates in Alternate Teacher Certification Programs and Add-On Programs. Students completing these programs will now be awarded a Post Baccalaureate Certificate by Southeastern.
