I. CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Campbell called the meeting to order at 2:05 p.m.

The minutes of the May 23, 2011 virtual meeting were approved by all members present.

II. DEPARTMENT OF COUNSELING AND HUMAN DEVELOPMENT

Dr. June Williams presented all items for this department.

Counseling:

a. Request for Change

1. CED 627 – Introduction to Play Therapy - CED 617 is no longer offered. Prerequisite change to reflect courses required for CED 617.
2. CED 683 – Counseling Practicum – Title change was needed to reflect consistency with the 2009 CACREP standards.
3. CED 685 – Independent Study in Counseling - Educational Foundations 600 was changed to HD 600 years ago. This is editorial change only.
4. SAC 619 – Substance Abuse Counseling – Removal of CED 619 reference in the catalog entry. The prefix was previously changed to SAC 619.

APPROVED by all members present.

b. Request for New Course

1. CED 623 – School Counseling Practicum – New accreditation standards require school counseling practicum to be completed in a school setting and to address specific standards which are significantly different from those in other concentrations.

APPROVED by all members present.

2. CED 680 – Advanced School Counseling - New accreditation standards require additional standards to be covered related to school counseling.

APPROVED by all members present.

FCS (Family and Consumer Sciences)

a. Request for Change

1. Catalog Pages 215–218:

Family Studies, Fashion Merchandising, Foods and Nutrition

Change in number of hours in concentration to less than 50% of major. Currently the number of hours in the core is 33. Currently the number of hours in the concentration is 36. In Family studies, the FCS Elective (3 hrs) in the concentration will be moved to the core. In Fashion Merchandising and Nutrition, one of the concentration electives will be changed to an FCS elective (3 hrs) and moved to the core. In all concentrations one concentration elective (3 hrs) will be moved from the concentration and to a free elective (3hrs). The number of hours which will be in core will be 36 and the number of hours in concentration will be 30.
