

Required Application Materials: Thesis program

A complete application (#1-6 below) is required to be considered for admission. Incomplete applications due to missing information will not be considered. It is the responsibility of the applicant to inquire about the status of their application

The application process consists of two steps. **First, applicants must apply to the university. This consists of completing a university application including the submission of transcripts and a GRE score.**

1) Completion of the university application, available at the following link:

2) Transcripts of all college coursework sent directly from the institution to the graduate coordinator.

3) A copy of your Graduate Record Examination (GRE) scores. TOEFL scores are also required for applicants whose native language is not English.

Second, additional items (#4-6) MUST be sent directly to the Interim Graduate Coordinator.

4) A brief resume or curriculum vitae.

5) A letter of intent, describing why you want to attend Southeastern and that you are applying to the thesis program.

****Students applying to the thesis program must contact a potential thesis advisor prior to applying to the program. A full time graduate faculty member in the department must be identified in your letter of intent and agree to serve as the thesis advisor. Potential advisors can be identified by reviewing faculty research interests listed on the department web page. Admission into the thesis program without the identification of a thesis advisor is unlikely.**

Applicants that fail to identify an advisor will not be considered for admission.

6) Two letters of recommendation.
