<sup>1</sup>Students with an ACT Math score of 20 or lower will take Math 155 (5 credit hours) in place of Math 161, which will increase by 2 credit hours the total number of hours required for the degree.<sup>2</sup>Students must complete 12 hours of a single foreign language.<sup>3</sup>Students must complete this requirement in one of the following ways:

a) successful completion of CMPS 110. b) a note from a teacher certifying successful completion of an English course scheduled in a computer lab. c) successful completion of English 322, 448,467, 485, or 486. d) successful completion of the English Department's computer literacy test.

NOTE: Students choosing option b, c, or d must also complete a three-hour free elective.

<sup>4</sup>Students must complete a minimum of 6 hours in a two-semester sequence of a biological science plus a physical science or a two-semester sequence of a physical science plus a biological science. See the General Education Requirements in the University Policies chapter of this catalog for the approved sequenced courses.<sup>5</sup>3 hours must be selected from the following courses: English 310, 316, 317, 369, 370, 373, 374, 392.<sup>6</sup>3 hours must be selected from the following courses: English 351, 352, 487.<sup>7</sup>3 hours must be selected from the following courses: English 430, 437, 455, 456, 457, 459, 488, 489, 490.<sup>8</sup>3 hours must be selected from the following courses: English 435, 436, 458, 471, 472, 487, 491.<sup>9</sup>3 hours must be selected from the following courses: English 312, 321, 322, 371, 372, 380, 413, 414, 447, 448, 467, 476, 477, 482, 483, 485, 486, 492, 493, 494.<sup>10</sup>3 hours must be selected from the following courses: English 426,428, 429, 438, 439, 449, 465, 475.<sup>11</sup>At least 3 hours must be 400-level courses.<sup>12</sup>Students may elect a course in Anthropology, Economics, Geography, Political Science, Psychology, or Sociology, excluding Geography 205.

†Major Course. Students are expected to take at least 6 hours in early literatures from the following courses: English 301, 351, 435, 436, 455, 456, 457, 471, 472.
