Program modifications instituted or being considered as a result of feedback received:

- The faculty is re-evaluating our institutional assessment plan in an effort to obtain helpful information for program improvement.
- Due to the low response rate and limited useful feedback received from the program evaluation question on the site supervisor's evaluation of the student, we will begin implementing a separate site supervisor survey focusing on program evaluation and feedback.
- Rather than a general survey of graduates and employers, we will begin surveying employers and graduates 3 years after their graduation date.
- Last summer we offered a special topics course in Advanced Grief as an elective and we are looking to expand our special topics offerings as elective courses.
- The faculty have emphasized a focus on case notes and documentation both in content courses and in clinical courses.
