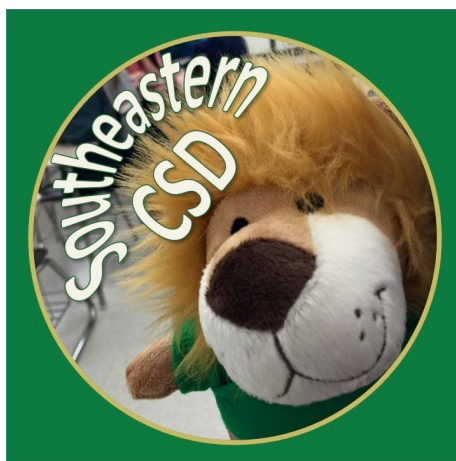

University Requirements

- Online admission application

- Application fee
- Immunization records

Graduate Requirements

- * Minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA.
- * Minimum 3.00 GPA on the last 2 years of under-graduate course work.
- * Minimum score of 138 on the GRE Verbal Reasoning, Quantitative Reasoning, and a 3.0 on the Analytical Writing.
- * Minimum 3 Letters of Reference (Use form on website)
- * Resume
- * Writing Sample-(Use stimulus on our website)



Coursework: Thesis Optional

Complete 42 hours CSD courses:

- CSD 602, 606, 607, 613, 614, 616, 617, 632, 633, 634, 628, and 687 & 6 hrs. of electives or thesis. Approximately 2 years, including summers, to complete.

Comprehensive Exam or Thesis

Clinical courses:

- Students with no direct clinical contact hrs. = 5 clinical practicum course.
- Students with at least 50 hrs. of direct clinical contact= 3 clinical practicum. courses
- Students with less than 25 hours of observation must enroll in CSD 328.
