The Department of Kinesiology and Health Studies at Southeastern Louisiana University invites applicants for a tenure-track Assistant or Associate Professor of Health Education and Promotion position to begin August 2009. Responsibilities will include teaching undergraduate and graduate courses in health (e.g., personal and community health, drug education, human sexuality, women's health, stress management). Additional responsibilities include academic advising, engaging in research and scholarly activities, and university service. The successful candidate must have a doctorate degree specializing in Health Education/Promotion or closely related field. ABD candidates may apply, however, to be eligible for the position, applicants must have completed all requirements for the doctorate degree by June 1, 2009. Desired qualifications include university teaching experience, evidence of scholarly productivity and potential to establish and maintain lines of research, and CHES certification.
