All students in the School of Nursing must be formally accepted to the nursing curriculum.

The information provided by the student in this application form will be treated confidentially and will be reviewed only by authorized committee members and staff.

The number of students selected for progression each semester may vary according to the resources available to the School of Nursing at the time. **All students eligible may not be accepted.**

All students must submit an Application for Progression in the School of Nursing by email or fax before enrolling in Nursing curriculum courses (Nursing 235). The application must be in the Office of the School of Nursing by May 1st for the summer semester, July 15th for the Fall semester, or December 1st for the Spring Semester.

A student who is not approved must re-file his/her Application for Progression for consideration for the next semester. Conference time will be scheduled at the student's request to review his/her application status.

Late Application Policy Statement:
Late applications may be accepted only if needed to fill open slots.

Determination of eligible students will be based on official records and grades that are in the School of Nursing (Hammond Campus) Office at the time of application. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE STUDENT TO SEE THAT ALL RECORDS ARE IN THE SCHOOL OF NURSING OFFICE BY THE DESIGNATED DEADLINE.** The School is not responsible for incomplete records.

For pre-requisite general education courses, an applicant must have a adjusted GPA of 2.7 or higher on all undergraduate hours attempted. If a student has been tentatively accepted drops below the required GPA or fails to complete course work, the student will no longer be eligible and may not enroll in the nursing courses.
