

Turtle Cove Self-Guided Boardwalk Sign Sponsorships

The Turtle Cove Environmental Research Station, Southeastern’s main field station, is accepting sponsorships for each of its 56 different wetland related signs. Ten of the signs are located on the first floor porch area and the main staircase at Turtle Cove and the Galva Canal Boat Shed in Manchac (designated as “premium sign locations”) with the remaining 46 noted as “boardwalk sign locations.” The signs are newly printed with hinged U.V. glass for sun and bird protection. A listing of the signs is on backside of this flyer. All funds raised support Turtle Cove’s research, education and outreach efforts in the Lake Pontchartrain/Maurepas Basin.



*A special sponsorship plate will be placed below the sign that states “**This Sign Sponsored By: ABC Company**” or “**Mr. and Mrs. John Doe.**” Customized wording is available, and for businesses could also include company logo, address and website.*

Sponsorship of each sign is for a term of 1 to 5 years. Contributions may be paid annually over or paid in one discounted lump sum for 5 years.

BOARDWALK SIGN - \$200 annually or \$800 (one-time pmt) for 5 years

PREMIUM LOCATION SIGN - \$500 annually or \$2,000 (one-time pmt) for 5 years
