✓ **Manage your Student ID**
You must carry your student ID with you at all times on campus – you will need it when picking up textbooks and much more! Campus Card Operations will be set up at Move In Mane-ia to issue cards to those students who have not already received a card. Visit southeastern.edu/lagniappe to add Lion's Lagniappe dollars to your account for use at vending machines, laundry machines, etc.

Be sure to review regulations regarding **television compatibility** (southeastern.edu/chartertv) to make your move to campus convenient for your tv needs. Bring a surge protector to protect your technology and painters tape if you would like to hang decorations in your room.

✓ **Purchase any needed supplies from On-Campus Marketing** University Housing, in conjunction with On-campus Marketing, coordinates move-in care packages, final exam care packages, and linens purchases. These kits are filled with delicious snacks and energy boosters which can be purchased by family and friends and will be delivered to your student. ✓ **Purchase Personal Property Insurance/ Renter's Insurance** The University is not responsible for your property in case of theft or damage. Property that you bring to school may be covered by your family's homeowners insurance. Your family should check with their agent to verify. If not, purchasing renters insurance is strongly recommended. Review suggested policies at southeastern.edu/liveoncampus

✓ **Communicate with your roommate** Connect with your roommate and discuss plans for your room. A sample list of items typically discussed by roommates can be found on our roommate agreement form located here: southeastern.edu/roommateagreement.

✓ **Complete Fee Payment** Please remember that all university fees must be paid before you can check-in to your new home or pick up your rental textbooks. Fee payment deadline is Friday, August 11 at noon. Payment options are :

1. Payment in Full (Log on to LEONET to pay your balance).
2. Anticipated Financial Aid adequate to cover the balance.
3. Southeastern Payment Plan set up with the processing fee and first installment paid.

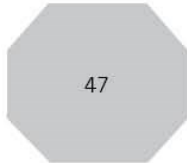
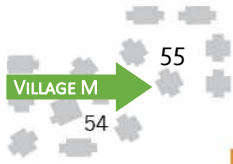
Your Room Assignment & Roommate Students are encouraged to make contact with their roommate prior to move in. View your room and roommate assignment by logging into the housing application portal at southeastern.edu/liveoncampus. Requests to change Residence Halls, rooms, or roommates will not begin until **September 1, 2017**. This will give you the opportunity to get to know your roommate and the environment before deciding if you really want a change. Your RA will have information needed to request a change.

Unable to attend Move In Mane-ia?

You may check-in August 14 or 15 between 9AM and 3PM at the University Housing Office in Pride Hall. Students who do not claim their assignment by August 16 are considered a “no-show” and their space is reassigned.

Mapping out your Route

- Anticipate short delays when dropping off your student's belongings. Once the vehicle has been unloaded, please move the vehicle to the overflow lots to allow other students to unload.

- Drink plenty of water to stay hydrated. Water stations noted on map.

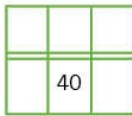

Register your Bicycle: If you choose to bring a bicycle to campus, register it with University Police in Pride Hall. Bicycle locking stations are located near each facility for your convenience.; you will need to provide your lock.

Scooters, Skateboards and other coasting devices: You are welcome to use your skateboard or other coasting device for transportation on campus. The All Access Plan offers unparalleled flexibility, variety, and value. For instance, with unlimited meals you can enter the Mane Dish every 30 minutes, leaving you plenty of opportunities for grabbing a drink or snack on the go. You're also given flexible variety with Cub Cash, all to use on any of our excellent on-campus dining locations.

Left Over Balance?

Cub Cash Balance rolls through fall to spring typically, so left over balance will carry over during this period! In other words, Cub Cash expires at the end of the Spring Semester.

However, expiration only applies to residential plans - this does not apply to Voluntary and Commuter plans, which never expire.
