

Continuing Education

The Division of Continuing Education and Special Activities' main functions are the coordination of all non-credit and special activities, both on and off-campus, and the coordination of off-campus credit courses and telecourses. Continuing Education strives to meet the needs of the non-traditional student as well as the needs of business, industry, government, and the public sector. The division offers a variety of camps during summer, and is also responsible for reserving Southeastern's facilities to off-campus groups.

Accomplishments of Continuing Education during the 2005-2006 academic year include:

- ❑ 7,876 enrolled in academic courses at nineteen off-campus sites
- ❑ 11,750 enrolled in electronically delivered courses - 595 classes
- ❑ 261 students enrolled in non-credit courses resulting in 50.1 CEU's awarded
(due to hurricane Katrina, several classes were canceled)
- ❑ 4,067 students participated in Summer Camp Programs
- ❑ 35 off-campus groups reserved Southeastern's facilities, attracting over 20,000 visitors to the campus
- ❑ 1,482 workers attended the Incumbent Worker Training Program
- ❑ 149,248 individuals attended events at the University Center (not including students attending classes)
