- Exit Survey** - Completed by all graduating students the semester they graduate. Two parts. The first part is for assessment purposes and asks questions about student satisfaction with various aspects of their major. Each major is allowed up to 10 questions specific to the major. The second part is conducted the last two weeks of the semester and asks about students plans after graduation.
- Entering Freshmen** - Asks questions regarding: Sources of Information about Southeastern; Personal & Social Development; General Education Skills; Reasons for Attending Southeastern; Participation in Extra Curricular Activities; Expectations of Southeastern; Demographic Information. Also includes questions regarding athletics as part of our Title IX/OCR requirements.
- Student Opinion of Teaching** - The SOT instrument contains standard items to be used for teaching performance evaluation and will allow for narrative comments from students. Confidentiality of students input will be maintained.
- Alumni** - Asks about post graduation education, employment, licensure/certification, satisfaction with Southeastern. Also repeats the student satisfaction questions from the Exit Survey.
- Current Student Survey** - Part of the survey changes from year to year and was developed to provide units on campus with institutional effectiveness data. Sections that are repeated year to year: Communication with Students, to help determine best way to communicate with students; Technology, originally developed to meet Student Technology Fee reporting requirements; Participation in Campus Activities; Opinion of Southeastern; Athletics, to meet Title IX/OCR requirement; Satisfaction with and Importance of Campus Services; Demographic questions not otherwise collected.
- Faculty & Staff Survey** - The major purpose of the survey is to provide data for various departments on campus for use in institutional effectiveness. One consistent question regarding satisfaction with various campus services, the rest are designed for different departments on a rotating basis.
- Non-Returning Students Survey** - Phone survey of students from previous year's cohort who did not return and were not suspended. Purpose is to gather information as to why students did not return.
- Campus Climate Survey** - Mandated by law, asks questions regarding experiences, attitudes, beliefs and behaviors related to campus climate and sexual violence. The survey is administered by a third party selected by the Board of Regents.

Student Satisfaction Inventory - Survey developed and administered by Noel Levitz. All system institutions participate every odd Spring.

NSSE - National Survey of Student Engagement. Provides comparative nation wide data. Currently being used as part of QEP assessment.

Several other surveys are also conducted on a regular basis or ad hoc basis, but are for specific units and/or groups, e.g. Study Abroad, Dual Enrollment.
