MAJORS

The major program in Psychology requires 40 semester hours in courses normally offered by the Department of Psychology, including 101, 102, 204, 220, 221, 222, 333 or 334, 343, 410, 422, 440, 462, and two 3 hour psychology electives-one at the junior level (300) or above, and one at the senior level (400). Students for whom there is any possibility of graduate study in Psychology are strongly advised to pursue Psychology 421 and 449. Candidates for the bachelor's degree in Psychology must earn, at Southeastern, a minimum of 21 hours required in the major field.
