ORIENTATION (ORNT)

101. Freshman Orientation.

Credit 1 hour. An accelerated course taught during a two day period prior to registration. A review of the background, policies and services of the university. The course is designed to help new students adjust to college life, and is required of any student who is enrolled at Southeastern Louisiana University for the first time and who is classified as a freshman (i.e., has earned 29 semester hours or less). The course is graded on a Pass/Fail basis.
