90. Transitional English.

Credit 5 hours. Composition and basic grammar and mechanics as they apply to essay writing. Course strengthens critical thinking skills and may incorporate Service Learning and Supplemental Instruction. Internet and compressed video classes are available. Credit hours earned do not count toward graduation. The final course grade will be on a Pass (P) or Unsatisfactory (U) basis.

92. Transitional Math.

Credit 3 hours. A study of basic algebra skills and their applications, using the graphing calculator. Course strengthens critical thinking skills and may incorporate Service Learning and Supplemental Instruction. Internet and compressed video classes are available. The final course grade will be on a Pass (P) or Unsatisfactory (U) basis. Credit hours earned do not count toward graduation.
