

LIBRARY SCIENCE (LS)

102. Introduction to Information Research. Credit 1 hour. A course designed to teach the information research process. Methods for locating and evaluating sources and the creation of effective search strategies are discussed and practiced. Required exercises and assignments reinforce the course content. (Summer, Fall, Spring)

421. Library Practice. Credit 3 hours. Prerequisites: Library Science Administration 403/503, 404/504, 405/505 and Library Science Education 401/501 or 402/502. Six hours a week work-experience in Sims Memorial Library; practice in the selection, acquisition, and organization of library materials; the use of these materials; and library administrative duties. Education majors will schedule Library Science Administration 422 (School Library Practice). (As Needed)
