Business Research Center U. S. real gross domestic product increased at a 6.9 percent annualized rate during the fourth quarter of 2021.

Year-over-year, 4Q2021 real GDP was 5.5 percent higher than in the fourth quarter of 2020.

Total civilian employment for the fourth quarter of 2021 increased 3.6 percent compared to 4Q2020. The labor force increased by 0.8 percent, resulting in a decrease in the unemployment rate from 6.8 percent in 4Q2020 to 4.2 percent in 4Q2021.

"Core" Personal Consumption Expenditure (PCE) index to 6.7 percent for the Consumer Price Index (CPI).

A 9.5 percent year-over-year increase in the Producer Price Index (PPI) portends more inflation at the consumer level in future quarters.

The cessation of Federal stimulus payments and higher inflation rates led to year-over-year declines in real disposable income of -4.3 percent in 2Q2021, -0.9 percent in 3Q2021, and -0.3 percent in 4Q2021.

Year-over-year inflation indicators for 4Q2021 ranged from 4.6 percent for the

Louisiana Economy

Louisiana total employment for the fourth quarter of 2021 was up 1.0 percent from the prior quarter and 1.4 percent over 4Q2020. Total employment remained approximately 83,000 below the level in 1Q2020, the last pre-COVID quarter.

The statewide labor force for 4Q2021 declined by 0.2 percent from the previous quarter, and 1.6 percent compared to 4Q2020.

With total employment up and the labor force shrinking, the unemployment rate declined from 6.2 percent in the previous quarter to 5.1 percent in 4Q2021.

Initial unemployment insurance claims in 4Q2021 were down 78.5 percent compared to 4Q2020, and continued claims were down 76.9 percent.

Statewide sales tax collections (not including motor vehicles) in 4Q2021 increased by 25.6 percent compared to 4Q2020.

Seasonally-adjusted state personal income in 3Q2021 increased 1.0 percent from the previous quarter and 4.0 percent compared to 3Q2020. Year-over-year, net earnings rose 6.9 percent, dividends, interest, and rent increased 1.5 percent, and personal transfer receipts fell by 0.5 percent.

Industries contributing the most year-over-year growth in earnings from 3Q2020 to 3Q2021 were *Construction* (+\$1.6 billion), *Accommodation and food services* (+\$1.5 billion), and *Mining* (+\$1.3 billion).

Three industries reported year-over-year declines in earnings: *Utilities* (-\$163 million), *Finance & insurance* (-\$154 million), and *Federal government* — *civilian* (-\$136 million).

On a percentage basis the largest gains in earnings were in *Farm earnings* (+40.5 percent), *Accommodation and food services* (+31.1 percent), and *Mining* (+18.1 percent).



Northshore Employment

Total employment among Northshore residents in 4Q2021 was up 2.0 percent from the prior quarter, but still down 2.2 percent (~5,600 jobs) compared to 1Q2020 — the last "pre-COVID" quarter.

The total Northshore civilian labor force in 4Q2021 grew by 0.6 percent compared to the previous quarter.

The Northshore unemployment rate decreased to 3.4 percent from 4.6 percent in 3Q2021.




Northshore Sales and Use Tax Collections (not including Tangipahoa Parish)

Northshore sales and use tax collections in 4Q2021 (excluding Tangipahoa Parish, for which data were not available) averaged \$44.3 million per month, an increase of 17.5 percent over 4Q2020.

Year-over-year collections were up in three of the four parishes for which data were available, from +19.5 percent in St. Tammany Parish to +25.3 percent in St. Helena Parish.

Washington collections were down 8.2 percent.

Northshore Residential Home Sales

There were 2,272 Northshore homes sold during 4Q2021 at an average price of \$273,096. The number sold was down 12.6 percent and the average price was up 7.6 percent compared to

4Q2020, leading to a 5.9 percent decrease in total residential sales volume.


Average days on market in 4Q2021 was 27, compared to 49 in 4Q2020.

Northshore New Domestic Business Filings

There were 2,003 new domestic business filings in the Northshore Region in 4Q2021, an increase of 13.9 percent compared to 1,758 in 4Q2020.

Filings were up in all five parishes, from 7.7 percent in St. Tammany Parish to 227.3 percent in St. Helena.

Livingston Parish

The number of employed Livingston Parish residents in 4Q2021 grew by 2.2 percent compared to the previous quarter, returning to approximately the pre-COVID level of 1Q2020.


The unemployment rate in 4Q2021 fell to 2.7 percent from 3.7 percent in the prior quarter.

Sales and use tax collections in Livingston Parish in 4Q2021 averaged \$13.6 million per month, up 19.6 percent compared to 4Q2020.

The number of residential building permits was not available for Livingston Parish for 4Q2021.

The number of homes sold in 4Q2021 was down 3.6 percent compared to 4Q2020, while the average price increased 9.0 percent to \$240,753, resulting in total residential sales volume increasing by 4.8 percent year-over-year. Average days on market in 4Q2021 was 27, compared to 51 in 4Q2020.

There were 412 new domestic business filings in Livingston Parish in 4Q2021, an increase of 13.2 percent compared to 364 in 4Q2020.



St. Helena Parish

Employment among St. Helena Parish residents in the fourth quarter of 2021 was up 2.2 percent compared to the previous quarter. The labor force decreased by 0.9 percent, leading to a decrease in the unemployment rate from 9.6 percent in 3Q2021 to 6.7 percent in 4Q2021.

Employment in 4Q2021 returned to the same level as in 1Q2020, the last pre-COVID quarter.

Sales and use tax collections in St. Helena Parish in the fourth quarter of 2021 averaged approximately \$515,000 per month, an increase of 25.3 percent compared to 4Q2020. Building permit data were not available for St. Helena Parish for 4Q2021.

There were nine homes sold in St. Helena Parish in 4Q2021 at an average price of \$196,689, increases of 50.0 percent and 26.5 percent, respectively, compared to 4Q2020. The total residential sales volume of \$1.8 million was up 89.8 percent year-over-year.

There were 36 new, domestic business filings in St. Helena Parish in 4Q2021, an increase of 100 percent from 18 in the prior quarter and 227 percent from 11 filings in 4Q2020.

St. Tammany Parish

The number of employed St. Tammany Parish residents in 4Q2021 increased by 1.7 percent compared to the previous quarter, but remained 5.3 percent (~6,300 jobs) below its level in 1Q2020, the last quarter before COVID.

Sales and use tax collections in St. Tammany Parish averaged \$27.6 million per month in 4Q2021, an increase of 19.5 percent over 4Q2020.

The number of permitted residential building units in 4Q2021 was down 32.8 percent compared to the fourth quarter of 2020. (Note: Multi-family permits are not included in the data for unincorporated St. Tammany Parish.) The number of homes sold in St. Tammany Parish in 4Q2021 was down 14.2 percent compared to 4Q2020, while the average selling price was up 6.8 percent to \$314,314, resulting in a 8.4 percent decrease in total residential sales volume.


Average days on market was 27 in 4Q2021, compared to 49 in 4Q2020.

There were 995 new, domestic business filings for St. Tammany Parish businesses in 4Q2021, up 7.7 percent from 924 in 4Q2020.

Tangipahoa Parish

The number of employed Tangipahoa Parish residents in 4Q2021 increased by 1.8 percent from the previous quarter, while the civilian labor force declined by 0.1 percent, causing the unemployment rate to fall from 6.6 percent in 3Q2021 to 4.7 percent in 4Q2021.

Employment in 4Q2021 climbed to 1.2 percent (~ 650 jobs) above its pre-COVID level in 1Q2020.

Sales tax data were not available for Tangipahoa Parish for 4Q2021.

The number of residential construction permits issued in 4Q2021 was up 74.3 percent compared

to 4Q2020, but the number of permitted units was down 60.8 percent.

The number of homes sold in Tangipahoa Parish in 4Q2021 declined by 23.7 percent compared to 4Q2020, while the average selling price increased by 9.5 percent to \$223,825, resulting in a decrease in total residential sales volume of 16.5 percent. Average days on market in 4Q2021 was 22, compared to 37 in 4Q2020.







Washington Parish

The number of employed Washington Parish residents in 4Q2021 increased by 3.7 percent compared to the previous quarter.

Employment in 4Q2021 surpassed by 0.9 percent (\sim 140 jobs) its level in 1Q2020, the last pre-COVID quarter.

Sales and use tax collections in Washington Parish averaged \$2.6 million per month in 4Q2021, down 8.2 percent compared to 4Q2020.

The number of building permits issued and the number of permitted units in 4Q2021 were both down 35.0 percent compared to 4Q2020.

The number of Washington Parish homes sold in 4Q2021 was 6.8 percent lower than in 4Q2020, but the average sales price increased by 10.2 percent, resulting in a year-over-year increase in total residential sales volume of 2.7 percent.

Average days on market in 4Q2021 was 44, half of the 88 days in 4Q2020.

There were 93 new, domestic business filings in Washington Parish in 4Q2021, down 26.8 percent from 127 in the prior quarter, but up 14.8 percent from 81 in 4Q2020.
