  - <sup>5</sup> At least 3 hours of general electives must be at the 400 level.
  - <sup>6</sup> Students whose ACT in Math is 20 or less must take Math 155
  - <sup>7</sup> Twelve hours to be chosen from the following: 371, 372, 380, 447, 482, 483
