

Extended Studies 2011 - 2012



The Division of Extended Studies' main functions are the coordination of all non-credit and special activities, both on and off-campus, and the coordination of off-campus credit courses. Extended Studies strives to meet the needs of the non-traditional student as well as the needs of business, industry, government, and the public sector. The division offers a variety of academic, cultural and recreational youth camps during the summer.

Accomplishments of Extended Studies during the 2011-2012 academic year include:

- » 2,271 academic course enrollments in 18 off-campus sites.
- » 684 students enrolled in non-credit courses resulting in 131.4 CEU's awarded
- » 4,787 students participated in one of the 12 Summer Camp Programs
- » 81 off-campus (third party) groups reserved Southeastern's facilities, attracting over 14,713 visitors to the campus
- » 1,155 Field experience opportunities for teacher candidates
- » 318 students attended the Community Music School
