The goal of the division is to provide the highest quality products and services to the Southeastern community. Some of the Fall 2013-Spring 2014 highlights from Auxiliary Services departments include:

- » 2,900 meal plans sold in Fall 2013; 2,500 meal plans sold in Spring 2014
- » Opened 4 new dining concepts in the new Student Union addition in Spring 2014

- » Fall 2013 University Housing occupancy of 100%
- » The Document Source served over 5,000 customers and printed more than 10,000 customized Southeastern graduation invitations.
- » Non-Credit Programs enrolled 1,265 total students in non-credit courses (not including dual enrollment, compressed video, or credit courses in off-campus locations) and awarded 809.6CEUs
