

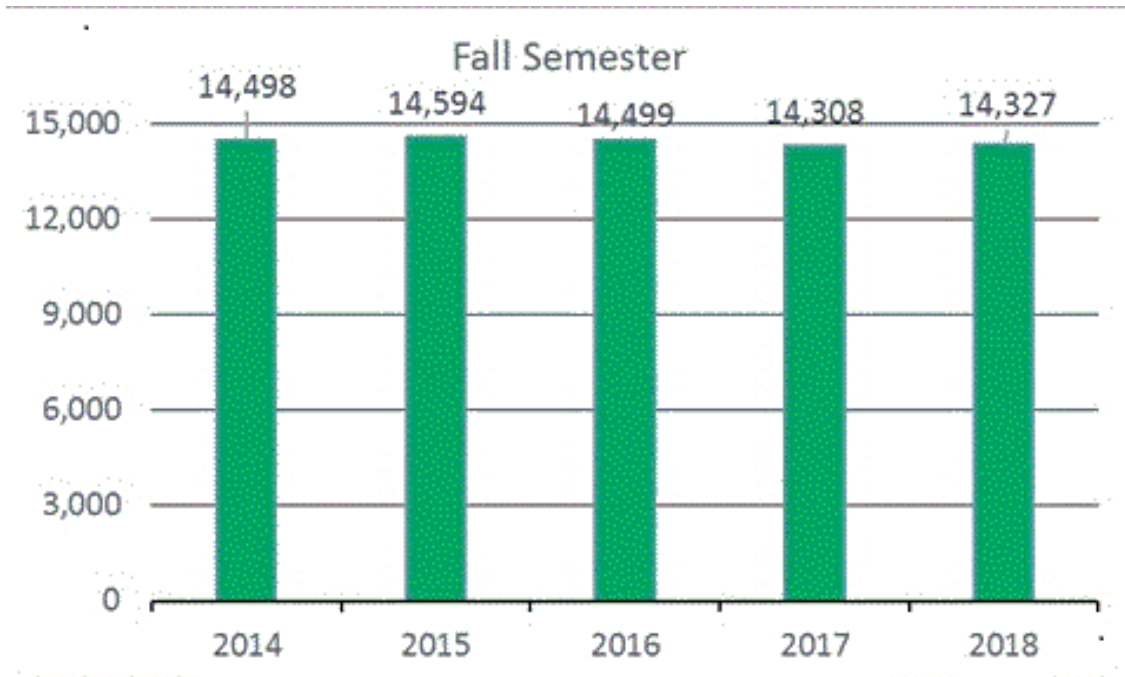

## Longitudinal Enrollment

Southeastern's total student enrollment increased by 0.1% from the Fall 2017 semester to the Fall 2018 semester. This reflects a 0.1% increase in undergraduate enrollment and a 0.1% decrease in graduate enrollment. Graduate enrollment includes students in Alternate Certification Programs.



## Minority Enrollment

The enrollment of minority students increased to 33.0% of total enrollment compared to 32.5% in Fall 2017.

## Average Course Loads

The average course load of undergraduate students is 11.8 hours which is an increase from 11.6 in Fall 2017. The average course load for graduate students (including Alternate Certification students, Master's plus 30, and Extended Studies students) is 7.0 hours, which is an increase from 6.9 in Fall 2017.

## Freshmen Cohort ACT Scores

The average ACT Composite score remained the same, 22.5, from Fall 2017 to Fall 2018.

(Note: These FTE calculations are based on the undergraduate and graduate hours taught by departments. These calculations will differ from FTE calculations based on the student classification of undergraduate and graduate.) The number of full-time equivalent undergraduate students equals the total undergraduate student credit hour (SCH) production divided by 12, and the number of full-time equivalent graduate equals the total graduate SCH production divided by 9.

## Top Six Parishes

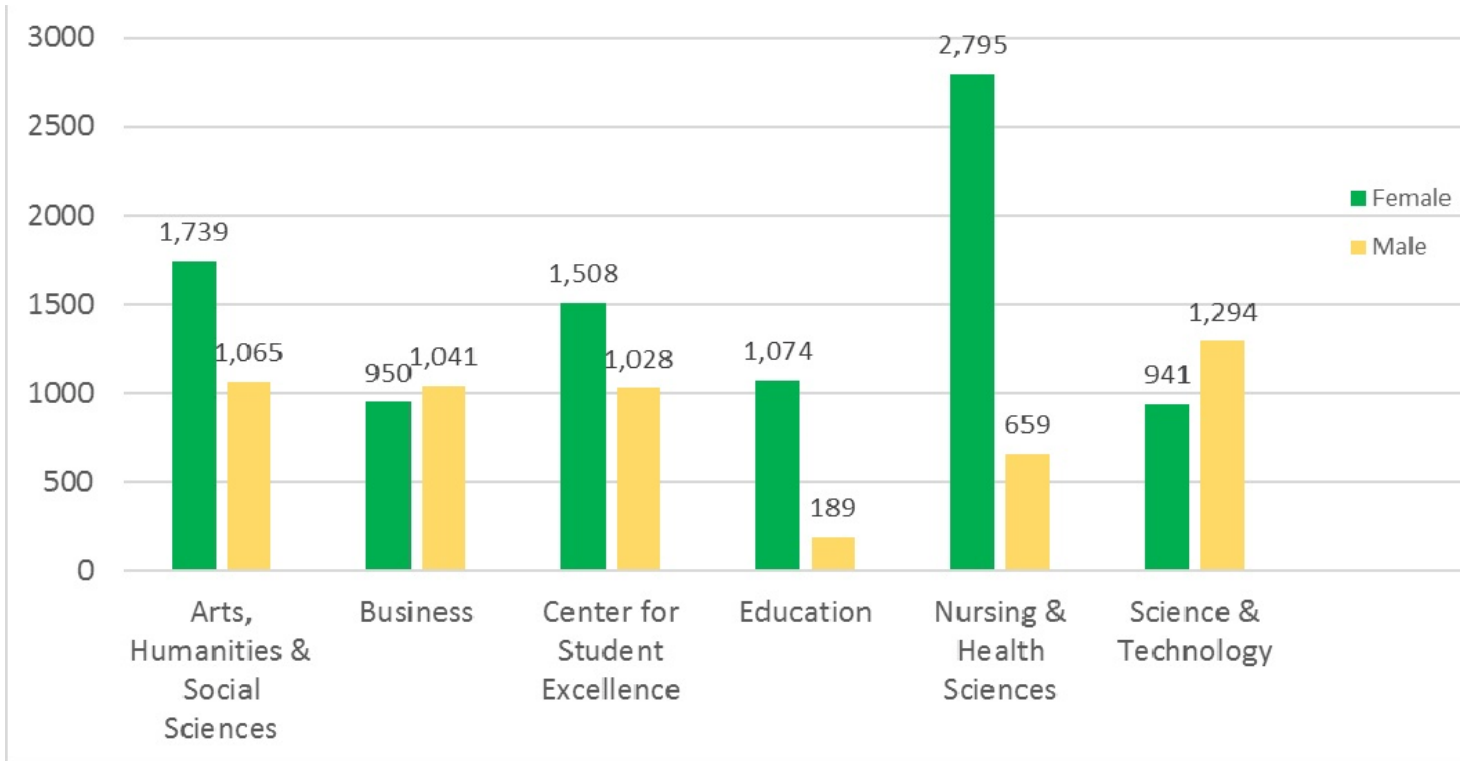

With 3,272 students, St. Tammany is the most represented parish. Compared to Fall 2017, Jefferson Parish had the largest increase (8.7%) in undergraduate enrollment. Ascension Parish had the largest percent increase in graduate students with an increase of 19.1%.
