Council for Teacher Education

- 1. Dr. Bill Neal called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

Dr. Thornhill stated that under "List other departments/colleges that could be affected by the proposed changes" that "and Human Development" be added to "College of Education".

Motion for item A was made, seconded and passed.

6. Nominations for (1) undergraduate representative and (1) graduate representative were taken. Reneisha Cherry was nominated as the undergraduate representative. Mary Prater was nominated as the graduate representative. Both were elected unanimously.

Nominations for (2) school system representatives were taken. Daniel Williams, from the Tangipahoa Parish School System, and Dorable Dangerfield, from the St. Tammany Parish School System were nominated. Both were elected unanimously.
