1. Minimum GPA of 3.25 (cumulative or last 60 hours) from a health related field:
 - BS in Athletic Training
 - BS in Health Sciences
 - BS in Kinesiology
 - BS in Biology
 - BS in Health Systems Management
 - BS in Communication Science Disorders
 - BS in Family Consumer Sciences
 - BSN in Nursing
 - BA in Social Work

2. Completion of most prerequisite courses:
 - Medical Terminology
 - Research Methods
 - Statistics
 - A course in human disease and/or pathophysiology

Review of Applications and Admissions Interviews:

Program Application Admission Deadlines for Fall Admission, all application materials must be submitted to the Graduate Coordinator no later than June 30. For Spring Admission, all application materials must be submitted to the Graduate Coordinator no later than November 1. Upon evaluation of application materials, qualified applicants may be invited to participate in an interview. Interviews may be on campus or held via video conferencing.

Admission to the Population Health Management program is selective and requires a favorable evaluation by the Population Health Management Program Admissions Committee. Within 14 days after participation in the program admission interview, all applicants will be notified via email regarding the admissions decisions.
