Social Work 203 and Social Work 204 and GBIO 107 and Sociology 212 may be concurrent registration. 1. Students may utilize elective for Child Welfare grand requirements. 2. Social Work, Sociology, Psychology, Political Science, Anthropology, Geography (except 205), and Family and Consumer Sciences. 3. Students may not schedule SW 497 and SW 498 until completion of all curricula requirements and prior social work courses have been completed. They must also have a minimum adjusted grade point average of 2.5.
