To Indicate Time

first . . . second . . . afterward later soon as soon as first of all meanwhile subsequently at first formerly then next immediately before thereafter now earlier in time previously to begin with finally in turn simultaneously until

To Show Comparison

also in comparison likewise similarly

To Show Contrast

although however nonetheless whereas but in contrast nor yet conversely instead on the contrary

despite meanwhile rather even though nevertheless still

To Introduce Examples

for example particularly thus for instance specifically to demonstrate namely such as to illustrate

To Indicate Conclusions or Summaries

as a result finally in other words thus
as stated before hence in sum to conclude
briefly in brief in summary to summarize
