

# Graduating Class Profile 2021-2022

#### **Executive Summary**

Each summer, the Office of Institutional Research prepares the Graduating Class Profile Report. This year's report contains information on the 2021-2022 graduates. Basic demographics are included as well as information on how long the graduates have attended Southeastern and from which institutions students last transferred.

During the 2021-2022 academic year Southeastern conferred a total of 2,186 awards, a decrease of 4 awards from 2020-2021. Sixty-six percent (66%) of baccalaureate degree recipients are White, Non-Hispanic, while sixty-six percent (66%) are female.

#### Some highlights include:

- Twenty-four percent (25%) of the graduates classified as Beginning Freshmen graduated within four years. This is one percentage point higher from the 2020-2021 graduating class.
- For transfer students, Southeastern's leading feeder school are Northshore Technical Community College followed by Baton Rouge Community College, Louisiana State University, Delgado Community College, River Parishes Community College, University of Louisiana-Lafayette, Louisiana Tech University, Nicholls State University, University of New Orleans, and Northwestern State University.
- The undergraduate baccalaureate program with the highest number of graduates in 2021-2022 was the BGS General Studies, followed by BSN Nursing, BS Biology, BA Management, BA Psychology, and BS Kinesiology.
- The baccalaureate programs (at least 5 graduates) with the highest percentage of students who began as transfers are: BGS General Studies followed by BSN Nursing, BS Biology, BS Accounting, BA Art, and BBA Business Administration. In contrast, the programs with the lowest percentage of transfers are BS Occupational Health, Safety & Environment, followed by BS Communication Sciences & Disorders, BS Supply Chain Management, BS Health Sciences, BS Information Technology, and BA Sociology.
- Seventy percent (73%) of the baccalaureate degree recipients started at Southeastern as Beginning Freshmen. This is up three percentage points over last year.
