

Graduating Class Profile 2022 -2023

Executive Summary

Each summer, the Office of Institutional Research prepares the Graduating Class Profile Report. This year's report contains information on the 2022-2023 graduates. Basic demographics are included as well as information on how long the graduates have attended Southeastern and from which institutions students last transferred.

During the 2022-2023 academic year Southeastern conferred a total of 2,185 awards, a decrease of one award from 2021-2022. Sixty-nine percent (69%) of baccalaureate degree recipients are White, Non-Hispanic, while sixty-nine percent (69%) are female.

Some highlights include:

- Twenty-eight percent (28%) of the graduates classified as Beginning Freshmen graduated within four years. This is three percentage point higher from the 2021-2022 graduating class.
- For transfer students, Southeastern's leading feeder school are Baton Rouge Community College followed by Northshore Technical Community College, Louisiana State University, Delgado Community College, River Parishes Community College, University of Louisiana-Lafayette, Nicholls State University, University of New Orleans, Southwest Mississippi Community College and Jacksonville College.
- The undergraduate baccalaureate program with the highest number of graduates in 2022-2023 was the BGS General Studies, followed by BSN Nursing, BA Psychology, BS Biology, BA Management, and BA Marketing.
- The baccalaureate programs (at least 5 graduates) with the highest percentage of students who began as transfers are: BGS General Studies followed by BSN Nursing, BBA Business Administration, BS Kinesiology, BS Biology, BA Management, and BA Criminal Justice. In contrast, the programs with the lowest percentage of transfers are, BS Elementary Education followed by BS Information Technology, BS Occupational Health, Safety & Environment, BS Computer Science, BS Early Childhood Education, and BA English.
- Seventy-six percent (76%) of the baccalaureate degree recipients started at Southeastern as Beginning Freshmen. This is up three percentage points over last year.
