**Goal 1**

To provide the skills necessary to work in the field.

A. Expected Outcome

Students will be able to demonstrate effective communication skills with clients, teachers, parents, colleagues, and supervisors.

Assessment

100% of the graduates will receive a proficient rating on 90% of the items found on the Counselor Competency Scale.

B. Expected Outcome

Students will be able to implement planning, managerial, and evaluation techniques for their selected counseling setting.

Assessment

- a. 90% of the employers will rate the graduates of the counseling program as "satisfactory" or better on an Employer/Supervisor Survey.
- b. 90% of the graduates will rate the components of the counseling program as "satisfactory" or better on a survey of graduates.

**Goal 2**

To provide the background needed to work in the field.

Expected Outcome

Students will be able to demonstrate a practical knowledge of the counseling profession such as normal and abnormal human growth and development, assessment of the individual, and counseling theories in both individual and group settings.

Assessment

\* 95% of the graduates will pass the National Board for Certified Counselors' Examination.
