**Goal 1**

Graduates with a M.Ed. in Counselor Education will demonstrate superior interpersonal and intrapersonal skills. Graduates will also have a sound professional knowledge base that will support them in a variety of settings including schools, community agencies, higher education, and private practice.

A. Expected Outcome

Students will be able to demonstrate skills and characteristics necessary to function in a setting appropriate to their field of concentration (community, school, or student affairs), including effective communication, adherence to ethical standards, individual and group counseling techniques, knowledge and implementation of philosophical foundations and satisfactory personal characteristics

Assessment

100% of the graduates will receive a proficient rating on 90% of the items found on the Counselor Competency Scale.

B. Expected Outcome

Graduates will express satisfaction with knowledge and skills acquired in the Southeastern Counseling Program.

Assessment

90% of the graduates of the counseling program will indicate on the alumni survey that they are satisfied with the counseling program and prepared for the job market.

C. Expected Outcome

Students will be able to implement planning, managerial and evaluation techniques for their selected counseling setting.

Assessment

All Practicum and Internship students will receive at least a satisfactory rating from their on-site supervisor on an evaluation form filled out by the site supervisor at least once each semester.

D. Expected Outcome

Students will be able to demonstrate knowledge necessary to become a professional counselor.

Assessment

90% of the students taking the Counselor Preparation Comprehensive Exam will pass on the first try.
