

Review of MFA Assessment Results and Report on Curricular Changes  
October 22, 2002  
Counseling Program

The Counselor Education faculty instituted the following changes and/or requests as a result of ongoing assessment of the program:

1. An exit survey has been added to the requirements for Internship in order to better assess the needs of students in the program.
2. A Marriage and Family Therapy Track has been added in response to student interest and in anticipation of the new licensure law for Marriage and Family Therapists in Louisiana.
3. Student feedback from the comprehensive exam has led to more emphasis on teaching content in the Group Counseling course.
4. Strengths in our program were noted in the pass rate for the NCE exam.
5. On-line courses in Career Counseling, Human Growth and Development, and Substance Abuse were added in response to student requests.
6. The interview process was revised as a result of student and site supervisor feedback.
7. The Internship was changed to a 2-semester requirement as a result of student evaluations from site supervisors and from feedback from students and supervisors.
8. A student data base for e-mail is being maintained in order to keep students better informed of policies, notices, and opportunities in the counseling program as a result of student feedback.
