


Semester Registration Report Spring 2015

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Longitudinal Enrollment

Southeastern's total student enrollment decreased by 0.6% from the Spring 2014 semester to the Spring 2015 semester. This reflects a decrease of 0.2% in undergraduate enrollment and a 5.0% decrease in graduate enrollment. Graduate enrollment includes students in Alternate Certification Programs.

The enrollment of minority students increased to 28.7% of total enrollment compared to 27.2% in Spring 2014.

Average Course Loads

The average course load of undergraduate students is 11.6 hours which is a slight decrease from 11.8 in Spring 2014. The average course load for graduate students (including Alternate Certification students, Master's plus 30, and Extended Studies students) is 6.9 hours, which a slight increase from 6.8 in Spring 2014.

Freshmen Cohort ACT Scores

The average ACT Composite score decreased from 21.1 in Spring 2014 to 21.0 in Spring 2015.

Full-time Equivalent (FTE) Students Taught

The number of full-time equivalent (FTE) students taught decreased 2.5% from the Spring 2014 semester to the Spring 2015 semester. (Note: These FTE calculations are based on the undergraduate and graduate hours taught by departments. These calculations will differ from FTE calculations based on the student classification of undergraduate and graduate.) The number of full-time equivalent undergraduate students equals the total undergraduate student credit hour (SCH) production divided by 12, and the number of full-time equivalent graduate equals the total graduate SCH production divided by 9.

Number of Hours Enrolled


Top Six Parishes

With 3,217 students, St. Tammany is the most represented parish. Compared to Spring 2014, Jefferson Parish had the largest increase (12.4%) in undergraduate enrollment. Jefferson had the largest percent increase in graduate students with an increase of 9.8%.
