


Semester Registration Report Spring 2016

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Longitudinal Enrollment

Southeastern's total student enrollment increased by 1.7% from the Spring 2015 semester to the Spring 2016 semester. This reflects a increase of 2.4% in undergraduate enrollment and a 5.9% decrease in graduate enrollment. Graduate enrollment includes students in Alternate Certification Programs.



Minority Enrollment

The enrollment of minority students increased to 29.8% of total enrollment compared to 28.7% in Spring 2015.

Average Course Loads

The average course load of undergraduate students is 11.1 hours which is a slight decrease from 11.6 in Spring 2015. The average course load for graduate students (including Alternate Certification students, Master's plus 30, and Extended Studies students) is 6.9 hours, which is the same as Spring 2015.

Freshmen Cohort ACT Scores

The average ACT Composite score decreased from 21.0 in Spring 2015 to 20.6 in Spring 2016.

Full-time Equivalent (FTE) Students Taught

The number of full-time equivalent (FTE) students taught decreased 2.1% from the Spring 2015 semester to the Spring 2016 semester. (Note: These FTE calculations are based on the undergraduate and graduate hours taught by departments. These calculations will differ from FTE calculations based on the student classification of undergraduate and graduate.) The number of full-time equivalent undergraduate students equals the total undergraduate student credit hour (SCH) production divided by 12, and the number of full-time equivalent graduate equals the total graduate SCH production divided by 9.

Top Six Parishes


