<p>Submit official transcripts to Office of Admissions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ High School or GED certificate ✓ All colleges that you have previously attended ✓ Military training transcripts (https://jst.doded.mil/smart/signIn.do) or Air Force (http://www.airuniversity.af.mil/Barnes/CCAF/Display/Article/803247/)

<p>PLACEMENT TESTING (if applicable) http://www.southeastern.edu/admin/testing/</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ACT is required for most admissions types; Check the requirements with admissions
<p>Register and Attend New Student Orientation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ALL beginning freshmen and transfer students with less than 30 hours of college credit are required to attend an Orientation program. • You should be contacted after being accepted regarding orientation registration
<p>Register for classes via LeoNet at http://www.southeastern.edu/student</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First-time class registration and academic advising will occur during orientation
<p>Submit Course Certification Form (CCF) each semester</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ You MUST submit a new CCF each semester that you enroll. If you make changes to your class schedule or withdrawal from a class, you <u>MUST</u> submit a revised CCF ASAP • If you are changing your program of study and/or institution, you <u>MUST</u> submit form 22-1995 to the VA ✓ The first time using your benefits, you will need to submit a copy of your DD214 and Certificate of Eligibility (COE). The COE will arrive in the mail approximately 30 days after you apply for VA benefits ✓ Financial aid will need an updated copy of your COE if you transferred from another institution where you used VA education benefits. Log in at https://www.ebenefits.va.gov/ebenefits/homepage • Request a deferment if you are waiting on your COE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ National Guard? Contact Mr. Leonard Acker to verify Tuition exempt status ✓ leonard.c.acker.civ@mail.mil (504) 278-8273
<p>Complete Third-Party Billing form with Accounts Receivable</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accounts receivable is located on North Campus in the financial aid building • Active duty? Ask Accounts Receivable about using your Military Tuition Assistance
<p>Obtain Parking Hang Tag \$60/Academic year</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Go to Self-service in Leonet, Select Registration, Select Term (Leave blank and click search), Enter your vehicle info, and agree to the Financial statement. ✓ After Registration, present your SLU ID in Pride Hall to receive parking hang tag
<p>If you have a Disability, stop at the Office of Disability Support Services to obtain an information pamphlet</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disability Support Services can be contacted at 985-549-2247 or disabilityservices@southeastern.edu
<p>Purchase Textbooks and Attend Classes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The rental fee for a courses which have rental books is \$50 regardless of the number of books/course
