- A. Brad Bergeron, Director of Academic and Career Exploration
Serve 3rd year through senior students. Launched “Ask Roomie”, an AI chatbot that targets undergraduate students to identify student needs. The chatbot identifies resources and follows up with the student. Humans also follow-up with identified students.
65,000 responses to check-in texts; 97% of students are users; 65% response rate from students to texts; 44,000 student needs uncovered & responded to. Using “Ask Roomie” will make it smarter. Faculty can Ask Roomie specific questions and discover how it answers. Feedback can be sent to ace@selu.edu

- B. Micheal Beckner, Head of the Southeastern Department of Public Safety
