Graduate Professional Education

One (10.0%) of the respondents is currently enrolled in a doctoral program and one (2.6%) has taken classes but not enrolled in a degree program. Five (50.0%) plan on enrolling in a graduate degree program in the future and four (40.0%) have no plans for further education. Two (40.0%) respondents plan on eventually obtaining a second masters, two (40.0%) a doctorate, and one (20.0%) a professional degree. The respondent with graduate experience, felt that Southeastern "Effectively" prepared them for further graduate education. They are enrolled in a program "Very Closely Related" to their Master's degree.

Employment

Eight (80.0%) of the respondents are currently employed full-time, one (10.0%) is employed part-time but looking for full-time work, and one has a graduate assistantship. The rest of them employment information is based on those who are employed full-time. Most alumni (75.0%, n=6) are employed in the state of Louisiana, while two (25.0%) are employed outside the state. Three (37.5%) are employed in higher education, two (25.0%) in government, one (12.5%) in a professional firm, and two (25.0%) in K-12 education. Two (25.0%) respondents indicated their education was "Very Effective" in preparing them for employment or improving their job performance, three (37.5%) indicated it was "Effective", one (12.5%) indicated it was "Ineffective", and two (25.0%) indicate it was "Very Ineffective". Three (37.5%) of the respondents are employed in an area related to their Southeastern master's degree and five (62.5%) in an unrelated area. Two (25.0%) respondents indicated a salary range of \$20,000-\$30,000, one (12.5%) indicated \$30,001-\$40,000, three (37.5%) indicated \$40,001-\$50,000, one (12.5%) indicated \$50,001-\$60,000, and one (12.5%) indicate \$70,001-\$80,000.

Overall Satisfaction with Southeastern

In general, respondents were satisfied with Southeastern. Forty percent (40.0%, n=4) had a Very Positive general attitude toward Southeastern, and an additional 50.0% (n=5) had a Positive general attitude toward Southeastern. One (10.0%) had a Neutral attitude. When asked if they would recommend Southeastern to a friend or family member considering graduate education, 50.0% (n=5) said they would with no reservations and 50.0% (n=5) indicated they would with some reservations.

The majority (80.0%, n=8) of the respondents indicated that if they were to do it again, they would elect to attend Southeastern for their Master's degree and two (20.0%) were not sure if they would. Respondents were also asked if their college education had improved the quality of their life, regardless of the financial benefits. The majority (90.0%, n=1) of the respondents indicated that the quality of their life had not improved.
