- » The Southeastern Professional Sales Program has been accepted as an associate member of the University Sales Center Alliance. Membership to the USCA is only extended to those sales programs that meet a set of highquality standards.
- » New Orleans attorney Ebony Morris has been named Southeastern Louisiana University's 2022 Young Alumna of the Year. Morris graduated from Southeastern in 2011 with a bachelor's degree in political science.
- » The undergraduate nursing program has been recognized by the Louisiana Nurses Foundation with the Nightingale Award as the Nursing School of the Year. The awards recognize the achievements of the nursing program's students and faculty. This is the fifth time Southeastern has been recognized with a Nightingale Award for the undergraduate nursing program.
- » The Industrial and Engineering Department recently received a \$25,000 donation from the Contractors Education Trust Fund and the Contractors Licensing Board. The contribution supports the IET Faculty Enhancement Endowed Fund, which provides resources to assist faculty in their professional and research activities in order to advance the activities and reputation of the Southeastern Industrial and Engineering Technology and OSHE programs.
- » For the 10th time, the Southeastern Channel has been recognized as the "Best College Television Station in the South." The channel earned first place "Best of South" honors for the fourth year in a row and the seventh time in the past 10 years at the annual Southeast Journalism Conference. Its seven years of winning "Best College TV Station" since 2013 are the most by any university in the southeast region of the U.S. During that time, when the Southeastern Channel didn't win first place, it won second place.

- » Management instructor Aristides Baraya has been appointed to the Latino Commission by the Louisiana Speaker of the House, the Hon. Clay Schexnayder. The main objective of the commission is to identify obstacles to the effective delivery of Louisiana state government services to Latin Americans, to propose methods to remove those obstacles, and to present proposals to the appropriate government entities.
- » Alumna Payton Onellion of Denham Springs has been selected as a finalist for Louisiana New Teacher of the Year by the Louisiana Department of Education. Onellion, who teaches in Livingston Parish, was one of only nine finalists selected from across the state.
- » A Southeastern Channel student-produced baseball broadcast has won national honors. The channel broadcast of the March 25, 2022, Southeastern vs. Nicholls State baseball game for live streaming on ESPN+ was named a national finalist for the College Sports Media Awards in Atlanta. The production was honored in the "Collegiate Student" division for "Outstanding Live Game Production."
- » Southeastern has been admitted as a member institution to the Carnegie Project on the Education Doctorate, a consortium of over 125 institutions around the world focused on transforming the advanced preparation of educational professionals to lead through scholarly practice for the improvement of individuals and communities. Southeastern is the first and only university in Louisiana to be selected for membership in the organization.
