

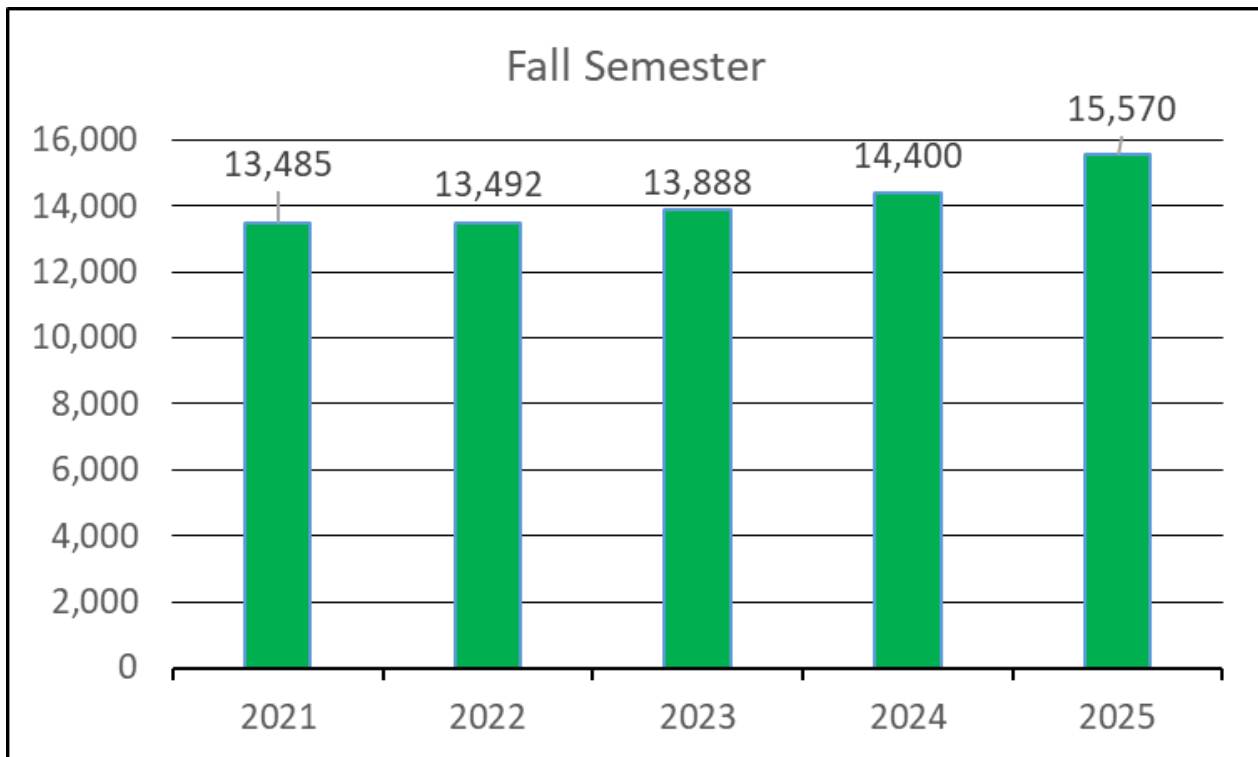

Longitudinal Enrollment

Southeastern's total student enrollment increased by 7.8% from the Fall 2024 semester to the Fall 2025 semester. This reflects a 21.5% increase in preparatory enrollment, a 3.1% increase in undergraduate enrollment and a 3.4% increase in graduate enrollment. Graduate enrollment includes students in Alternate Certification Programs.



Minority Enrollment

The enrollment of minority students increased to 36.4% of total enrollment compared to 34.1% in Fall 2024.

Average Course Loads

The average course load of preparatory students is 3.8. The average undergraduate students is 13.7 hours which is the same as Fall 2024. The average course load for graduate students (including Alternate Certification students, Master's plus 30, and Extended Studies students) is 7.7 hours, which is an increase from 7.4 in Fall 2024.

Freshmen Cohort ACT Scores

The average ACT Composite score decreased to 22.4 as compared to 22.6 in Fall 2024.

Full-time Equivalent (FTE) Students Taught

The number of full-time equivalent (FTE) students taught increased 5.6% from the Fall 2024 semester to the Fall 2025 semester. (Note: These FTE calculations are based on the undergraduate and graduate hours taught by departments. These calculations will differ from FTE calculations based on the student classification of undergraduate and graduate.) The number of full-time equivalent undergraduate students equals the total undergraduate student credit hour (SCH) production divided by 12, and the number of full-time equivalent graduate equals the total graduate SCH production divided by 9.

Top Six Parishes

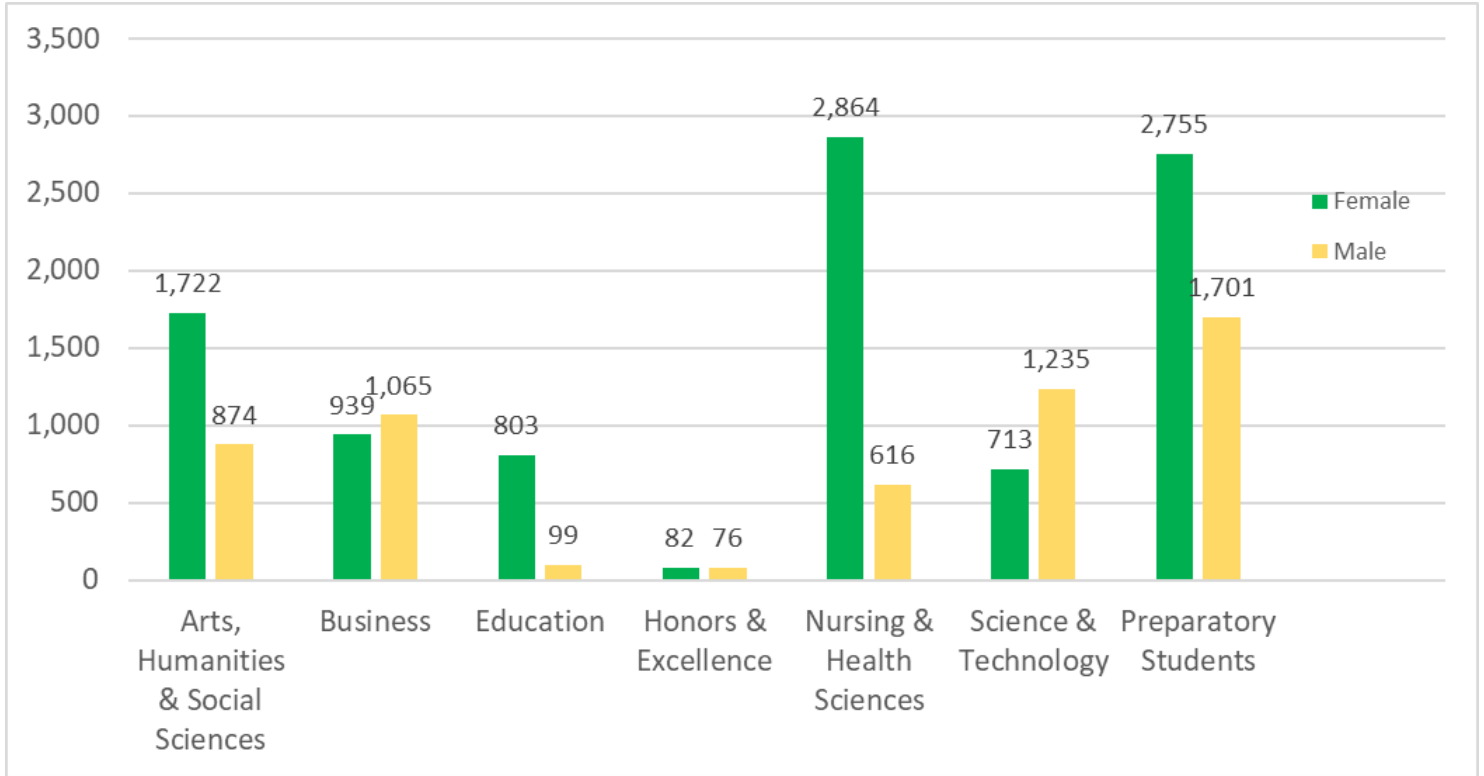
The six parishes which most of Southeastern’s Louisiana resident students claim as a home parish are the parishes listed in the table below. With 3,439 students, St. Tammany is the most represented parish. Compared to Fall 2024, Livingston Parish had the largest increase (30.0%) in Preparatory students, Jefferson Parish had the largest increase (9.1%) in undergraduate enrollment, and Ascension Parish had the largest percent increase in graduate students with an increase of 38.6%.

The number of female students enrolled at Southeastern increased by 8.8% from Fall 2024 to Fall 2025; male students increased 6.2%. There were a total of 9,886 females students enrolled and 5,674 male students enrolled.
