

#### **Longitudinal Enrollment**

Southeastern's total student enrollment increased by 7.8% from the Summer 2024 semester to the Summer 2025 semester. This reflects a 11.6% increase in undergraduate enrollment and a 4.9% decrease in graduate enrollment.



#### **Minority Enrollment**

The enrollment of minority students increased slightly to 33.9% of total enrollment compared to 32.1% in Summer 2024.

#### **Average Course Loads**

The average course load of undergraduate students is 5.6 hours, which is a slight decrease from Summer 2024's 5.7 average. The average course load for graduate students (including Alternate Certification students, Master's plus 30, and Extended Studies students) is 5.2 hours, which is a slight increase from 5.1 in Summer 2024. In Summer, a full-time undergraduate student is enrolled in 6 or more hours and full-time graduate students in 4 or more hours. Part-time undergraduate students are enrolled in less than 6 hours and graduate students in less than 4 hours.

#### **Freshmen Cohort ACT Scores**

The average ACT Composite score increased from 21.7 in Summer 2025 to 22.2 in Summer 2025.

The number of full-time equivalent (FTE) students taught increased 6.6% from the Summer 2024 semester to the Summer 2025 semester. (Note: These FTE calculations are based on the undergraduate and graduate hours taught by departments. These calculations will differ from FTE calculations based on the student classification of undergraduate and graduate.) The number of full-time equivalent undergraduate students equals the total undergraduate student credit hour (SCH) production divided by 6, and the number of full-time equivalent graduate equals the total graduate SCH production divided by 4.

### **Top Six Parishes**


