Public History: CRMP 411; GEOG 103; POLI 201; 9 hours from History 463, 466, 467, 483, 484.

<sup>2</sup> To be taken from Anthropology, Criminal Justice, Economics, Geography, Political Science, and Sociology with at least 3 hours at the 200-level or above.

<sup>3</sup> To include both Physical and Biological Sciences, at least 6 hours of which must be in a two-semester sequence.

<sup>4</sup> Twelve (12) semester hours in one foreign language (taken sequentially) are required.

<sup>5</sup> Field experience assignments for CRMP 491 and 492 and research topics for HIST 488 and 497 will be tailored to the student's area of specialization.
