NOTE: Math 161 if Math ACT \geq 21 or Math 151 if Math ACT \leq 19. Students with a Math ACT \geq 28 are eligible to be placed in Math 177.

Courses taken concurrently:

- Completion of an approved Introductory Portfolio is a prerequisite for EDUC 320 and EDUC 322
- Completion of an approved Developing Portfolio is a prerequisite for EDUC 453.

All courses must be completed before Student Teaching II (EDUC 427)
