## Strategies for Using Your Learning Style Strength

## **AUDITORY LEARNER**

The Auditory leaner learns best by listening, talking to others and self. In other words, they "know something by hearing it".

**REMEMBER:** Good study habits are important for everyone, regardless of their preference.

These include:

- highlighting and study cards for textbook information,
- good lecture notes with a 'recall' column,
- frequent review,
- keeping up with assignments, etc.

## "HEAR IT to LEARN IT"

TEXTS:

- Read important information out loud.
- Explain things to yourself as you are reading.
- Make study cards and recite them to yourself frequently.
- When you finish a chapter, TAPE a summary and listen to it.
- Get books on tape if necessary.

LECTURES:

- TAPE THEM! Use the 'pause' button to edit out irrelevant information. Listen to your tapes soon after the lecture.
- Take notes in class. Use the 'recall' column to orally recite the information and guiz yourself.

STUDYING:

- READ it WRITE it SAY it.
- Describe diagrams, illustrations and charts out loud or discuss it with someone else.
- Join a study group.

**GENERAL:** 

- Take classes that rely on LECTURES for information
- Tape your classes
