

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN HEALTH STUDIES
MAJOR FIELD ASSESSMENT

The Bachelor of Science in Health Studies is designed to prepare graduates of certificate and/or associate degree programs in health care specialties for entry-level management, supervisory, or health education positions. Admission is limited to individuals who are currently enrolled in, or have completed an accredited certificate or associate degree program in a health care specialization (e.g., radiologic technology).

GOAL 1: Graduates of the B.S. in Health Studies will possess the knowledge, skills, and dispositions required of health professionals as they deliver services to clients and/or agencies.

Expected Outcome 1.1:

80% of students will be evaluated favorably (a score of 3 or better on a 5 point scale) during their senior-level internship experience focusing on skills and competencies of the professional health educator/manager, including (1) planning health programs, (2) implementing health programs, (3) evaluating health programs, (4) coordinating the provision of health education services, and (5) managing the delivery of health services.

Expected Outcome 1.2:

On the Alumni Survey, 75% of graduates will express agreement (rating of 3 or higher on a 5-point scale) with the following item:

- My degree helped me learn the knowledge and skills required of my profession.
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GOAL 2: Graduates of the B.S. in Health Studies will evaluate aspects of their undergraduate preparation program favorably on the Senior Exit Survey and Alumni Survey.

Expected Outcome 2.1:

On the Senior Exit Survey, 75% of graduates will express satisfaction (rating of 3 or higher on a 5-point scale) with the preparation they received in terms of instruction and professional experiences. The following items will be scored:

- Overall quality of the degree program
- Effectiveness of the faculty as teachers
- Quality of instruction in professional courses

Expected Outcome 2.2:

On the Alumni Survey, 75% of alumni will express satisfaction (a score 3 or better on a 5 point scale) with the preparation they received on the following items:

- Overall quality of the degree program
- Effectiveness of the faculty as teachers
- Quality of instruction in professional courses
- Practicum experiences outside the classroom.

GOAL 3: Graduates of the B.S. in Health Studies will respond favorably relative to items reflecting preparation to function in a multi-cultural workplace.

Expected Outcome 3.1:

On the Senior Exit Survey, 75% of graduates will express agreement (rating of 3 or higher on a 5-point scale) with the following items:

- Courses and field experiences in my degree adequately dealt with issues related to multi-cultural issues.
- I am comfortable working with colleagues/students/clients who are different from me in terms of race/culture/ethnicity.

Expected Outcome 3.2:

On the Alumni Survey, 75% of graduates will express agreement (rating of 3 or higher on a 5-point scale) with the following items:

- Courses and field experiences in my degree adequately dealt with issues related to multi-cultural issues.
- I am comfortable working with colleagues/students/clients who are different from me in terms of race/culture/ethnicity.
