Southeastern now operates its own television station, The Southeastern Channel, in partnership with Charter Communications. In addition to programming from sources such as the Annenberg Channel and NASA-TV, the station airs educational programming, telecourses for credit, lectures and cultural programming featuring Southeastern faculty and students. The Southeastern Channel provides an ideal training opportunity for students interested in television production.

Faculty and staff at Southeastern received nearly \$17 million in outside grants and contracts last year, funds that supplement academic and research activities. Major grants received include funding from the Environmental Protection Agency for ongoing wetlands research at the university's Manchac Swamp research station, Turtle Cove; GEAR-UP, a \$1.2 million U.S. Department of Education-funded program designed to improve student achievement and raise educational aspirations among junior high students; and "Project Teach," a \$1.2 million five-year program designed to improve and increase the number of teachers qualified to work with students who speak limited English.
