- » Southeastern's Phi Kappa Phi Honor Society was recognized as a Chapter of Excellence, the highest commendation a chapter can receive from the organization.
- » Southeastern Channel was named first in the nation by College Broadcasters, Inc. at the National Student Production Awards.
- » Southeastern received a Student Actions award from Purposeful Networks for student leadership and engagement in positively impacting the community.
- » Southeastern's education program was ranked 15th in the nation for value by the National Council on Teacher Education (NCTW)
- » For the fourth year, Southeastern was named a Military Friendly School by Victory Media, publisher of G.I. Jobs, the premier magazine for military personnel transitioning to civilian life.
- » Southeastern's graduate program in Biological Sciences was ranked sixth in the nation in the fall Biology Grad Rankings posted by the website graduateprograms.com
- » Southeastern's Sustainability Center has been awarded the Operational Excellence Champion Award by the Louisiana Chapter of U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC Louisiana).
- » Southeastern's Occupational Safety, Health, and Environment program has been recognized by the Board of Certified Safety Professionals as an exceptional program holding superior program accreditation. Southeastern's program is one of only 26 recognized nationwide and the only in the state of Louisiana.

- » Southeastern has been named to the state's inaugural list of the Governor's Military and Veteran Friendly Campuses. The designation was designed to commend those institutions that have gone above and beyond to create a supportive environment for veteran and military students.
- » U.S. News and World Report listed Southeastern among the top regional universities in the South where students graduate with the least debt.
- » Col. Stanley John Whidden, a U.S. Army physician and scientist and an expert in incident management, chemical and bioterrorism risk analysis, was named Southeastern's Alumnus of the Year.
- » The Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP) renewed a seven-year reaccreditation of Southeastern's College of Education. The agency applauded the university's efforts and reported that the commission's findings indicated no areas requiring improvement related to any of the standards.
- » Southeastern's application for reaffirmation of accreditation by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) was approved in December 2015 at the SACSCOC annual meeting.
- » Southeastern's Epsilon Phi Chapter of Delta Tau Delta Fraternity was the recipient of the prestigious Hugh Shields Flag, presented to only the top 10 chapters across the United States. It marks the 16th time the chapter has been named among the fraternity's top 10.
