2018 - 2019 Highlights

- » Enrollment in fall and spring Honors classes was 26% higher in 2018-19 (n=935) than in 2017-18 (n=741).
- » Thirty-one students earned Sophomore Honors Distinction for completing 15 hours of Honors courses with no grade lower than a 'B' by the end of their fourth regular semester in 2018-19, a 517% increase over 2017-18.

- » Twelve seniors presented their theses and earned the Honors or Scholars Diploma in 2018-19, the same number as the previous year. The disciplines in which the theses were completed attest to the breadth of the Honors Program: Biology, Computer Science, English, Mathematics, Psychology, and Teaching and Learning were each represented.
- » Honors Graduates in 2018-19 were admitted to a number of graduate and professional schools including the doctoral program in Industrial-Organizational Psychology at Louisiana Tech University, the Masters of Library Science program at Valdosta State University, Louisiana State University New Orleans School of Medicine, Southern University Law School, and Southeastern's graduate programs in Counseling and Biology.
